

Google Classroom

- Classroom for each Dinyat and Quran class
- Used for announcements, material, and assignments/assessments
- Invites to Student's gmail id (if present) or to parent's gmail id between Sept. 5 10
- Click on 'join' button on e-mail to join class
- Email will be sent automatically when Teacher posts any items
- Ensure notifications are turned on / check spam folder
- Download free google classroom App on your phone to get notifications every time something is posted

Google Classroom Guidelines

- Review posts each week using link in e-mail OR accessing online classroom OR via google classroom App
- Students to complete and turn in assignments by due date
- Encourage students to ask questions via comment option if not sure or don't understand
- Material posted in Google Classroom is for student's use only; it cannot be downloaded, printed, or shared outside of our Madrasah's use

Live Virtual Classroom Guidelines

- Check meeting room info in Google Classroom, Classwork, Zoom Meeting Link
- Join meeting room on time and mute microphone to avoid background noise, attendance is taken within 1st 10 min.
- Islamic dress code is mandatory/maintain hijab
- Turn on video to enhance the learning experience
- Encourage participation in discussions and activities
- Use Raise Hand Feature to participate in class discussion
- Do not post any negative or rude comments
- Do not record /share any portion of the online class
- Tools used to increase engagement: breakout rooms, whiteboard, annotation, jamboard, kahoot, menti, nearpod for interactive activities
- VAK visual, auditory, kinesthetic try to reach out to each child

Recitation

- Recitation will be done in breakout rooms
- During the **first two week** teachers will assess and record students recitation level and group them into beginner, intermediate and advance
- Students will recite Quran in their specific groups in breakout room with a teacher to guide them.
- Parents, please make sure your children come to the madrassah **on time** to be assessed.

Online Qur'an Tutoring

- We are piloting a Quran tutoring program until end of Oct. to support students who need extra coaching in reciting Quran
- Online Quran Tutoring sessions will be held Mon-Fri, at 5:15 pm 6 pm.
- There will be breakout rooms with mentors to help them recite correctly
- Once the Quran Teacher has assessed and recorded the placement level of the students in the tracker, the Coordinator will identify students and reach out to parents with more details for joining these sessions.

Tips/Guidelines for parents on how you can help your children grow closer to the Holy Quran

- Ask them what surah are they memorizing at madrassah.
- Practice recitation and memorization for at least 15 min per day
- Listen to the Holy Quran at home using different Apps or whilst driving.
- Encourage them to recite the surah they're trying to memorize at the dinner table, after salah, or when going on a drive, even if it is a few aayah.
- You can make it a team effort by telling them that you too are learning the surah with them!
- Everyone loves rewards treat them when they have learnt a sura or a tajweed rule.
- Take advantage of Quran Tutoring sessions for extra recitation practice







Tests are designed to assess their lower and higher order thinking skills and help us gage how much a student has understood the topic.





Parents: encourage child to recite out loud with class. Submit child's recording of the rhymes, etc. to Teacher so we can replace audio files with student content.

Salah Progam - Grades 5-YF

- Teacher will play audio files for adhaan, iqamah, Dhur, and Asr.
- Short video by a scholar will be included on some days
- Salaah program will be conducted as close to prime time as possible between classes

Parents:

- Encourage Students to participate in pray along with the audio files
- Can join in with students
- Encourage child(ren) to lead prayers for family

AL-HAADI STUDENT PROGRAMS

Mashallah Rewards Program

Objective:

To recognize and encourage good behaviour

Max. 5 points for each of Quran or Dinyat class plus 1 point for Salaat = max. 11 points per day

Maximum 200 stamps per student per year.

For Salaat: 1 point for reciting out loud/leading salaat, adhaan, iqamah, tasbih, dua after salaat, or ziyarat

Challenges: reward stamps per challenge program

| Points | Criteria in Quran or Dinyat Class |

| 1 | Join class on time, stay up to the end & turn on video for whole class (unless there is a pre-arrangement re: video turned off) |
| 1 | Completed homework or in class activity |
| 1 | Participation in class (e.g. responding to questions |
| 1 | 80% or higher (EA) in a test |
| 1 | Helping, volunteering, or other good behaviour (can allocate 1 more point if not used for test result category in that class) |

Frequency Annual

How to Apply:

Submit a summary of activities performed and number of hours, by May 8, 2022. Entries must be signed/initialed by Organization representative/parent.

Criteria

- 1. Participate or lead activities providing community service within madrassah, within mosque, within the community, etc.
- 2. All Volunteering activities count; must be performed on a volunteer basis (not a paid position).
- **3. Suggested activities:** fundraising for charity, helping at mosque programs, helping the elderly, visiting the sick, reading for those who are blind, teaching a skill, helping at food bank or shelter, etc.
- **4. Minimum total # of hours** performing community service during August, 2021 April, 2022:
 - **Community Class:** 5 hours
 - Grades 1-4: 5 hours
 - Grades 5-8: 10 hours
 - Grades 9-YF: 20 hours


