Highlights of 2023/2024

Highlights of 2023/2024

- Conducted 2-4 consultations per Sunday with students, parents, and volunteers.
- Updated Anti-Bullying Policy and Student Behaviour & Incident Management Policy
- Conducted a 2.5-hour training for new guidance counsellors and held workshops on Children's Mental Health and Coping with Grief.
- Began development of online reporting of incidents.

- Train at least 3 new guidance counsellors to better support students and staff.
- Conduct quarterly presentations and workshops on well-being topics for staff, parents, and students.
